FULL REOPENING OF 16TH ST SW

South Project Nears Completion

The City of Minot announces that 16th Street from Burdick Expressway to 16th Avenue SW will fully reopen to traffic on Tuesday, October 14.

With the reopening of 16th Street, the temporary neighborhood connection between 14th Avenue SW/Cook Drive and 18th Street has been removed permanently. Neighborhood residents can once again access their properties directly to and from 16th Street.

The temporary traffic signal at the intersection of 16th Street and 11th Avenue SW will remain in place until the permanent traffic signal and street lighting are installed in November, completing the south project. Brief, intermittent lane closures may be necessary during that installation period.



- Reconstructed 16th Street SW from 14th Avenue SW to Burdick Expressway with new concrete pavement
- Rebuilt the Burdick Expressway intersection
- Upgraded storm sewer, water main, and sanitary sewer infrastructure
- Installed new curbs, sidewalks, and shareduse path along the east side of 16th Street
- Improved roadway drainage and grading

Soon What's Next

- Permanent traffic signal and street lighting installation at 11th Avenue SW in November
- Final landscaping and cleanup along the corridor
- Once signal work wraps up, the South Project will be officially complete.
